A RESOLUTION
ADOPTING THE PROVISIONS OF THE NATIONAL INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE RESOLUTION NO. 101, s. 2021 IN CONFORMITY TO THE CONTINUED IMPLEMENTATION OF PROACTIVE MEASURES AND UNIFORM TRAVEL PROTOCOLS IN RELATION TO COVID-19 WITH ADDITIONAL GUIUAN IATF REQUIREMENTS AS ALLOWED BY THE NIATF

WHEREAS, the National Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) issued Resolution No. 101, series of 2021, dated February 26, 2021 providing for the continued implementation of proactive measures in relation to COVID-19 and the uniform travel protocols for land, air, and sea in close coordination with national leagues including the League of Municipalities of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government have issued Executive Order No. BPE 03-004 series of 2021, modifying the COVID-19 protocols in the Province of Eastern Samar in accordance with the provisions of the NIATF Resolution No. 101 on uniform travel protocols and for other purposes;

WHEREAS, the members of the Guiuan Inter-Agency Task Force thru an online meeting have agreed to adopt the policies specified therein, with some additional requirements that is allowed by the National IATF;

WHEREAS, for monitoring purposes, upon arrival in Guiuan, All travelers (LSI, ROFs, APOR, Others) shall be required to report to the Triage for health and physical assessment. If there is/are symptoms of COVID-19, Rapid Antigen and RT-PCR swab shall be conducted. If the result is positive, the person shall be confined at the Guiuan Ugtas COVID Center Community Isolation Unit for Ten (10) inclusive of the 3-day asymptomatic period prior to discharge.

1. On Locally-Stranded Individuals (LSIs)

A certification from the Barangay of origin of the traveler shall be required attesting that he/she is not a Person Under Monitoring (PUM), Person Under Investigation (PII), a Close Contact, or has not been exposed to a COVID-19 confirmed case. The said certification is to be communicated to the LGL's One-Stop-Shop thru their Hotline Numbers 0961-770-2024 and 0956-188-5227 for the issuance of Certificate of Acceptance.

All LSIs shall be required to observe the minimum health protocols of wearing face mask, physical distancing even inside their homes and is requested to stay at home within Seven (7) days upon arrival. If COVID-19 symptoms manifest, the LSI or any family member shall inform the Brgy. Frontliners and immediate swabbing shall be conducted for free at the Triage.

A certification from the Bureau of Quarantine or from the Dept. of Health shall be secured prior to their arrival, certifying that the person is free of COVID-19 or has a negative test result of COVID-19;

All ROFs shall be required to observe the minimum health protocols of wearing face mask, physical distancing even inside their homes and is requested to stay at home within Seven (7) days upon arrival. If COVID 19 symptoms manifest, the LSI or any family member shall inform the Brgy. Frontliners and immediate swabbing shall be conducted for free at the Triage.


3. For Authorized Persons Outside of Residence (APORs)
An official identification card and official Travel Order is to be presented at the border.
4. For Travelers from outside Eastern Samar with overnight stay
A certification from the Barangay of origin of the traveler shall be requested attesting that he/she is not a Person Under Monitoring (PUM), Person Under Investigation (PUI), a Close Contact, or has not been exposed to a COVID-19 confirmed case.
5. For Travelers with less than 24 hours and no overnight stay in Guiuan
No requirement.
6. For Travelers from Eastern Samar
No requirement.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, As it is Hereby Resolved to adopt the provisions of the NIATF Resolution No. 101, s. 2021 and to require from travelers documentary requirements, to report to the Guiuan Triage upon arrival and to voluntarily stay at home for 7 days upon arrival for LSIs and ROFs, and to submit for confinement at the Guiuan Ligas COVID Center Community Isolation Unit in case of positive COVID Rapid Antigen and RT-PCR Result.


