EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. AGK-04-11-52021

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER DECLARING THE TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS  
AND PROTOCOLS FOR VISITORS AND TOURISTS ENTERING THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF GUIUAN**

**WHEREAS**, it is a declared policy of the State to uphold the people's constitutional rights to life, health, safety and property and to promote the general welfare of its people at all times;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 11469 otherwise known as the "Bayanihan to Heal as One Act" was approved mandating all local government units to adopt and implement measures to prevent further spread of COVID-19 and ensure safety and well-being of all;

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Guiuan, Eastern Samar is under the Modified General Community Quarantine;

**WHEREAS**, Department of Tourism Region VIII has issued protocols for the entry of tourists to places in Eastern Visayas, including Guiuan;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to implement travel protocols for visitors and tourists entering Guiuan for tourism and leisure purposes amid the pandemic, especially during this summer season;

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government of Guiuan is committed to protecting and ensuring the safety and security of all Guiuananons;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANNALIZA P. GONZALES-KWAN**, Municipal Mayor of Guiuan, Eastern Samar, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

**Section 1. Travel Requirements for Entering Guiuan for Tourists and Visitors** – The Municipality of Guiuan, Eastern Samar is requiring the following documents for entering Guiuan as tourists and visitors:

For those coming from areas within Region 8:

1. Safe Guiuan QR Code ([www.safeguiuan.com](http://www.safeguiuan.com))
2. Valid ID

For those coming from low-risk areas outside of Region 8:

1. Safe Guiuan QR Code ([www.safeguiuan.com](http://www.safeguiuan.com))
2. Valid ID
3. Tourist Pass (to be secured from the Municipal Investment and Tourism Office)

For those coming from high-risk areas outside of Region 8 (MGCQ and GCQ areas, such as NCR Plus, Cebu, Davao, etc.):

1. Safe Guiuan QR Code ([www.safeguiuan.com](http://www.safeguiuan.com))
2. Valid ID
3. Negative RT-PCR (undertaken 3 days before arrival)
4. Tourist Pass (to be secured from the Municipal Investment and Tourism Office)

**Section 2. Entry Requirements to the Islands of Suluan and Homonhon**– All tourists and visitors from outside Region 8 and within Region 8 shall be required to register at the Municipal Investment and Tourism Office (MITO) and secure a Tourist Pass.

Tourists and visitors shall present their travel documents stated in Section 1 to secure the Tourist Pass. Upon embarkation at the designated ports, Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) personnel are to check the required documents mentioned in Section 1 hereof as well as the Tourist Pass together with the Shipping Manifest as a requirement for sea travel clearance. The same documents are to be checked by the designated Barangay Officials upon arrival to the islands of Suluan and Homonhon.. No Tourist Pass and travel documents, no entry.

Barangay Officials of the Islands of Suluan and Homonhon shall monitor the arrival of tourists and visitors to their respective barangays and ensure that travel requirements and protocols have been observed.

**Section 3. Tourist Establishments and Tourism-Related Services** – All tourists, establishments, such as resorts, hotels, tourism sites, and tourism-related services, such as pump boats and van transportation, shall require their clients to present the Travel Requirements stated in Section 1 prior to conducting business and/or offering their services. All establishments are to require their clients to log in upon entry via Guiuan QR Code.

**Section 4. Minimum Public Health Standards** – All tourists and visitors shall strictly follow the minimum public health standards:


1. Wearing of face masks and face shields;
2. Observance of the 1-meter physical distancing;
3. Proper Hand Hygiene

**Section 5. Penalties** – Non-compliance of this Executive Order shall be penalized under the provisions of R.A. 11332, that provides for non-cooperation of persons and entities that should report and/or respond to CoViD-19 suspected and confirmed cases.

Further, if the offense is committed by a public or private health facility, institution, agency, corporation, school, or other juridical entity duly organized in accordance with law, the Chief Executive Officer, President, General Manager, or such other officer in-charge shall be held liable. In addition, the business permit and license to operate of the concerned facility, institution, agency, corporation, school, or legal entity shall be cancelled.

**Section 6. Separability** – In any event that any provision of this Executive Order or any part hereof is declared invalid, contrary to law, or unconstitutional, the provisions not thereby affected shall remain in force and effect.

**Section 7. Repeal** – All other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.






**Section 8. Effectivity** – This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain to be in force until amended, modified or repealed, in whole or in part by subsequent national and/or local government issuances.
