EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. AGK-04-12-S 2021

DECLARING A SUSPENSION OF WORK IN ALL GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE OFFICES AND CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS OF BOTH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS ON APRIL 19, 2021 DUE TO TYPHOON BISING

WHEREAS, under Section 16 General Welfare Clause of Local Government Code of 1991," provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare, and to ensure, among other things, the preservation and promotion of health and safety;

WHEREAS, it has been issued by the DOST (PAG-ASA) that Typhoon Bising Warning Signal Number 2 over Northern Samar, Samar, Eastern Samar and Biliran;

WHEREAS, there is an imminent danger of loss of lives and properties;

WHEREAS, in anticipation of any developments that may arise out of the weather disturbance, it is but appropriate and fitting to implement a Localized Suspension of Work and Classes;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ANNALIZA P. GONZALES-KWAN, Municipal Mayor of Guiuan, Eastern Samar, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, hereby depose and say:

Section 1. Suspension of Work and Classes. Work is hereby suspended in all government and private offices and classes in all levels of both public and private schools on April 19, 2021, Monday, due to Typhoon Bising. Warning Signal Number 2 raised over Northern Samar, Samar, Eastern Samar and Biliran brought by Typhoon Bising and was located at 250kms ENE of Virac, Catanduanes (14.1N, 126.5E) with max sustain winds of 195kph and gust up to 240kph and moving NNW ward at 10kph.
